

SWL Out-of-Hours (OOH) Primary Care Centres (PCC) Location & Directions

Croydon PCC at Croydon University Hospital (CUH)

Address:
530 London Road, Thornton
Heath, Surrey, CR7 7YE.



Directions:

Enter via Emergency Department where the reception is on right. Proceed up until you see a vending machine on the right, after which there is set of double doors with GP Out of Hours above. Proceed to walk upstairs to the 1st floor. Turn right where the entrance is located for the service. Ring the bell to alert receptionist. For those with reduced mobility, keep walking past the double doors where there is a 2nd door on the right for lift access into service.

Preferably only the patient is to be in the waiting room when waiting to be seen. If required, only one additional person is allowed to avoid overcrowding in waiting area.

Richmond PCC at Oak Lane Medical Centre

The OOH Clinic is based within this GP Surgery which is easily visible along Oak Lane, with parking available at the rear of the building.



Kingston PCC at Kingston Hospital

Address: Phlebotomy Department, Kingston Hospital, Galsworthy Road, Kingston upon Thames, Surrey KT2 7QB



Directions:

From the main car park on Galsworthy Road, walk in the direction of the Accident & Emergency Department towards the right-hand side of the main building. Before reaching A&E you will pass the main outpatient's department; upon entering, the phlebotomy department is immediately on the left-hand side.

Wandsworth PCC at Queen Mary's Hospital

Address: UTC, Queen Marys Hospital, Roehampton Lane, London SW15 5PN



Directions:

Turn off Roehampton Lane into Queen Mary Hospital; the paid car park is on your right, with the hospital on your left. When walking into the main entrance to the hospital, the Urgent Treatment Centre (UTC) / MIU entrance where the OOH is based is just outside the main door on the right-hand side. It is a short walk from the car park.

Merton PCC at St. George's Hospital

Address: St James Wing, Fracture Clinic, St Georges Hospital, Blackshaw Road, London SW17 0QT



Directions:

From the main car park, walk towards A&E and turn right to get to the St James Wing entrance. Walk down the corridor past the lifts and turn right. Walk down this second corridor until you see signs for Outpatients and enter the outpatient department. The OOH reception is in front of you to the right.

Sutton PCC at St. Helier Hospital

Address: Ferguson House, St Helier Hospital, Wrythe Lane, Sutton SM5 1AA



Directions:

The OOH clinic is based in Ferguson House, which is separate to the main building of the hospital, but easily accessible from the car park. It is a walk down the main corridor and, in an area, called the Springall Annexe, which is up a few steps. For disabled access, the Springall Annexe will need to be accessed from round the back of Ferguson House.
